 <p>MDU Start, Stop, Transfer Services</p> <p>To Stop, Start, or transfer services, give them a call at 800-638-3278</p>	 <p>Your water, sewer and sanitation services (curbside trash and recycling collection) will all appear on one monthly bill. Receipt of your first bill will vary depending on move-in dates, billing cycles, etc.</p> <p>Landlords/Renters: If you are renting, work with your landlord to establish if the account will remain in their name, or if they want the utilities to be transferred to you during your residency. For renters, you will be charged a refundable deposit of \$125 to establish services. If your account is paid in full when moving/ending services, this money will be refunded to you upon moving from your residence.</p> <p>Recycling/Sanitation Services FAQs</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • When is my trash/recycling day? • What Can I Recycle? • What do I do with Green Waste/Yard Debris? For your convenience, a number of recycling and green waste drop sites are available throughout the community! • Landfill Coupons - City of Sheridan Residential/Commercial addresses associated with a current City utility account, receive six (6) free disposal coupons (up to 1-ton each) per year. 	
<p>*If you fall within the boundaries of the Downer Neighborhood Improvement Services District (DNSID) - please contact their office at 307-674-7491 to arrange utility services and monthly billing. While Downer is outside of City limits, Sanitation and Recycling services <i>may be</i> available, however they are typically billed at double the City rate. Some decide to hire a private sanitation company instead, so you'll need to decide what works best for you and your situation.</p>

Driver’s License	License Plates/Vehicle Registration

<p>If you have recently moved to Wyoming, you will need to apply for a Wyoming Driver’s License in person. You have one year from the time you establish residency to be issued a Wyoming driver license.</p> <p>The local Driver’s License Department and Records is located in the Cottonwood Center at 1949 Sugarland Dr #168, Sheridan WY 82801 (located next door to Shipton’s Big R Store)</p> <p align="center">Cost Estimates</p> 	 <p>Wyoming License Plates are county-specific. Once you’ve moved to Sheridan (County 3) and have established residence, you’ll visit the County Courthouse at 224 S. Main Street, 1st Floor.</p> <p>Retired persons moving to Wyoming have up to 120 days to register a vehicle in Wyoming. Otherwise, once you are employed and establish a residence (typically even if it is temporary) you are required to register your vehicle in Wyoming as soon as possible.</p> <p>To register a vehicle, you’ll need a Wyoming Title, or a current and valid out-of-state registration, proof of current auto insurance, and your vehicle’s VIN or NADA Numbers, which are used to calculate registration fees.</p> <p align="center"><i>Registration fees are due annually to the county.</i></p>

Pet-Parent Tips

Sheridan has been recognized as a [Dog Friendly City](#)! This recognition includes, but isn't limited to 1) The number of dog parks, 2) Availability of Dog Trails, 3) Amount of Pet Friendly Restaurants, 4) Options for pet-friendly lodging, 5) Availability of dog daycares, and 6) Emergency Veterinary Care.

Dog-Parks

The City has three great dog parks within City limits:

- Lions Dog Park, located at 526-598 N. Sheridan Avenue
- Huntington Bowl, located on Huntington St. in southwest Sheridan &
- North Park, located near the Thorne Rider Sports Complex in northern Sheridan
- *(Bonus: The information center at the 1-90 exit 23 also has a pet exercise area)*



License your dog (or adopt a new pet!)

If you brought your best friend with you, you'll visit the shelter to pay for your registration fees. The shelter is located at 84 East Ridge Rd in Sheridan, WY. Licenses are due annually on July 1st of each year and are typically \$15.00/dog.

City Code re: Cats/Dogs

- All dogs over the age of six months must be licensed and registered (and must be licensed/registered within 30 days of being brought into the City)
- Proof of rabies vaccination is required for all dogs and cats
- Any dog or cat found at large within the City shall be taken and impounded in the city dog pound by any policeman or poundmaster.
